Her work and her research have always been characterized by a strong social and civic engagement to which is added the capacity to investigate and a strong visual impact. Her work has been the subject of thesis at the Academy of Fine Arts in Carrara in 2001. Shows directed and performed by her have been presented in Italy, Europe, Africa, United States and Canada.

She's committed by the most important theatres, playing great characters of literature, classical and contemporary drama, directed by internationally renowned directors such as Luca Ronconi, Jury Ljubimov, Benno Besson. She also plays in Cinema, Television and Radio.

In 2009 she is appointed president of the Jury of the XXI Cairo International Festival for Experimental Theatre and Member of the International Jury of the XVII Damascus Film Festival.

She is director and founding member of AlcantaraTeatro and she has founded in Rome the Center of Theater Research ScenaMadre in 2001.

She is creator and artistic director of Festad'Africa International Festival of Contemporary African Culture, since 2002

She won the Golden Grolla as best actress Fiction 2006.

She has won numerous awards including the Golden Mask as best actress in 1993 and she has received a medal by the President of the Italian Republic for Festad'Africa Festival in 2009.
